Topic: First draft of User Stories for the duration of project approved by client. More information on the way the fire department is run

User Story 1:

As a fireman

I want to be able to look and see where I am assigned too

So that I can be efficient in getting to the emergency.

Volunteer Fire Command:

- Gets a page, not necessary to log in, that states whether or not they are going to respond to the fire. Commanding officer can see who is coming and load trucks accordingly.
- Make sure the web page is not too busy (i.e. KEEP IT SIMPLE)
- Create a submit button
- Position of where the truck is at fire matters, so the order to sending the trucks out matters, ergo the order of loading the trucks matter.

User Story 2:

As a commanding officer

I want to know when certificates expire

So that I can keep everyone safe.

Firefighter Certification Information:

- Every firefighter must go through exterior training, and this certification does not expire, ergo every firefighter has at least one certification.
- Interior certification is completed once; however they must pass a physical every year. When a firefighter has interior certification, they can, AT ANY TIME, state that they no longer wish to go inside during a fire. If this happens c.o. should be able to update the system to take them off the interior certification list.
- Rescue tools(i.e. jaws of life and herse tools) certification does not expire.
- Hazardous materials certification does not expire.
- Driver certification does not expire.
- Pump operator certification does not expire.
- New York State EMS certification is renewable for firefighters every four years.
- Paramedic certification is a permanent certification; however there are periodic skill assessment courses that must be taken every three years.
