

## Client Meeting Notes

11/9/10

### Discrepancy with Course Instructor's role

- We're not setting up something for the client to edit the site with, we are designing it in such a fashion so that the client can use Dreamweaver easily and then inject it
- We should refit the calendar inside the content table so that the client can edit it
- The table can then be stored as an html file
- Have to change our document and diagrams to show this correctly
  1. Context Diagram – draw it outside the box
  2. UML Diagram – draw it outside the box
  3. Non-Functional Requirement (if not already there) – “Changeable content will be easily editable”
  4. DO NOT change it in the Software Plan

### New Developments

- Client is rethinking the resource links situation. He may want to keep the links page, but put anchors in it so that when a user clicks on a link in the calendar, it jumps to that spot on the links page
- Client sent emails to Kurt and Dan with sample templates that have fixed menus and scrollable regions. We could probably set a defined width for the page and then have the scrollable region (calendar) be less than that defined width
- We will definitely have more than one table. Last time, client thought we may only need one but we now need a table of speakers that have come throughout the years. List them by alumni or by year, possibly.

### Possible Problems

- With the search results page, pop-ups can be blocked by pop-up blockers, so possibly have it in a new tab.
- HOWEVER, older versions of browsers may not have tabbed browsing. Firefox probably won't give us a problem because they release new versions all the time. Internet Explorer 7 was the first version to use tabbed browsing but it may not be the default. Also have to test with Safari and possibly other browsers. We'll have to decide with the client how far back we want to program for (version-wise).
- Could possibly use exception handlers. If we program it to display results in a new tab, and the browser isn't programmed for that, it will send out an error. We can then catch the reply and have it display the results in a new window.
