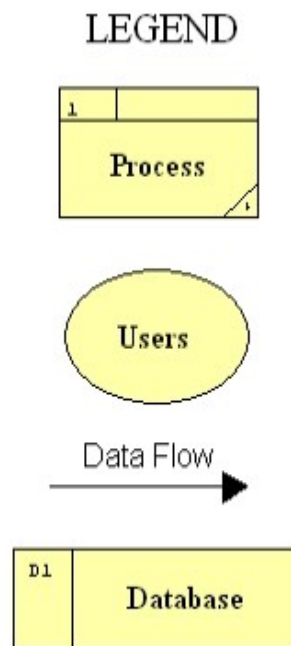

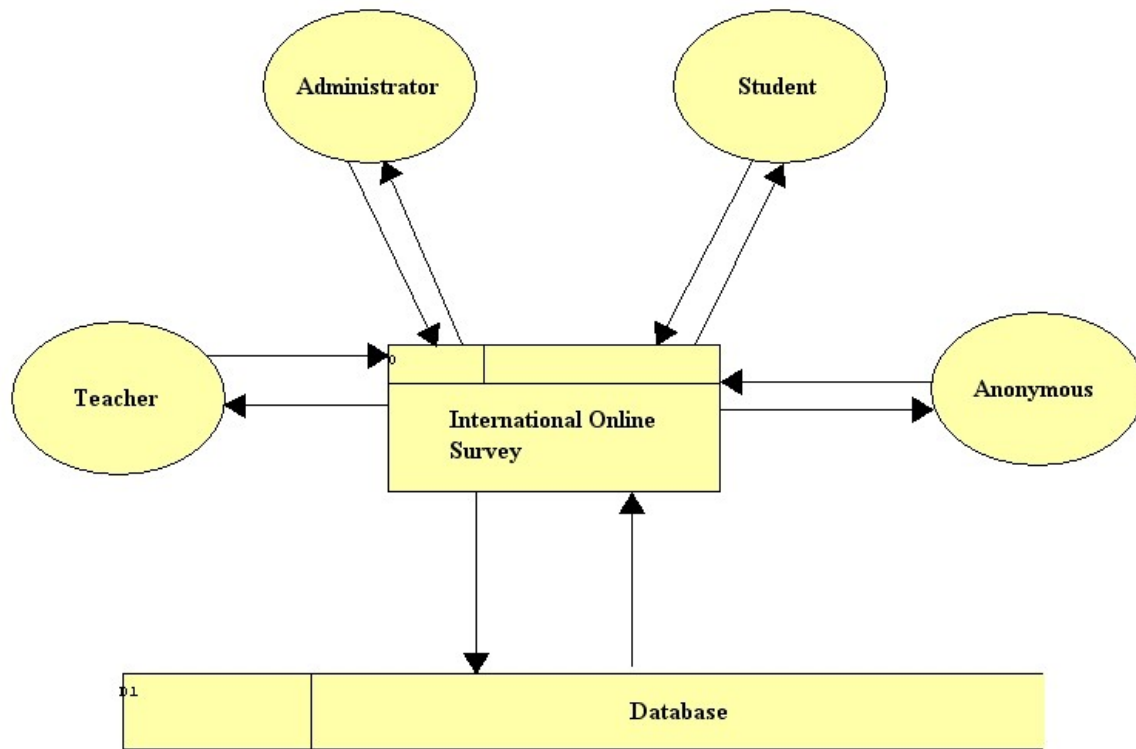

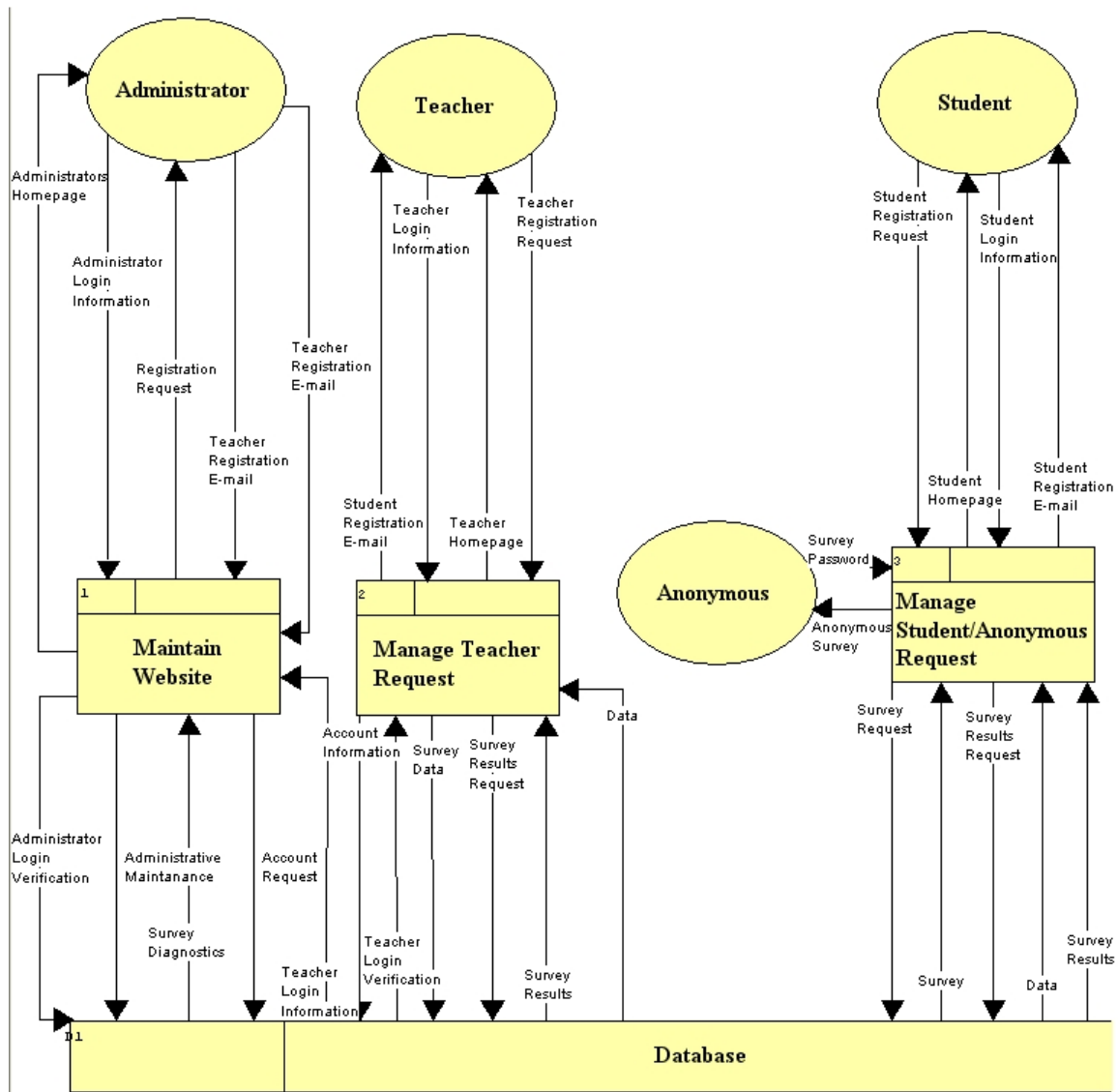


6.1: Context Diagram

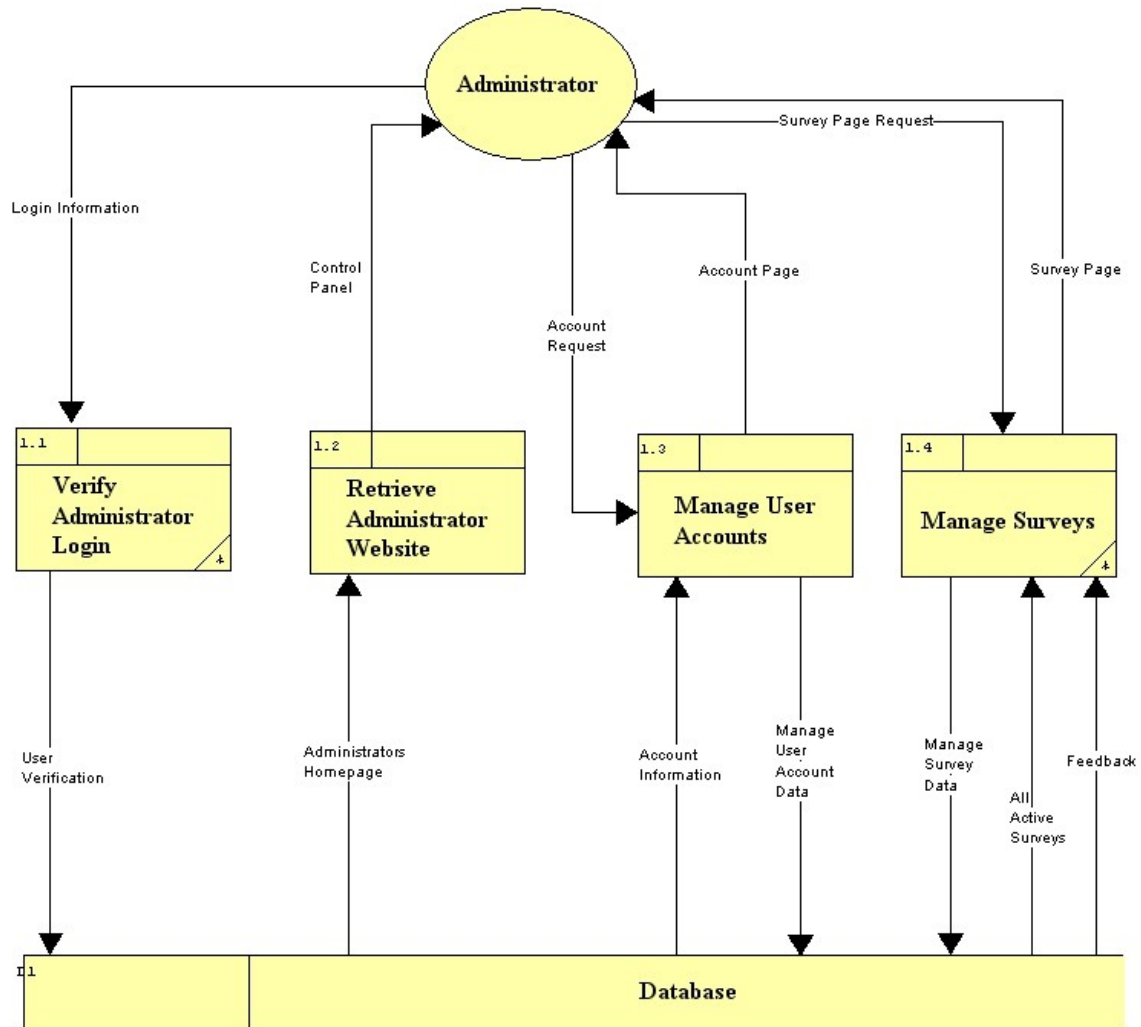

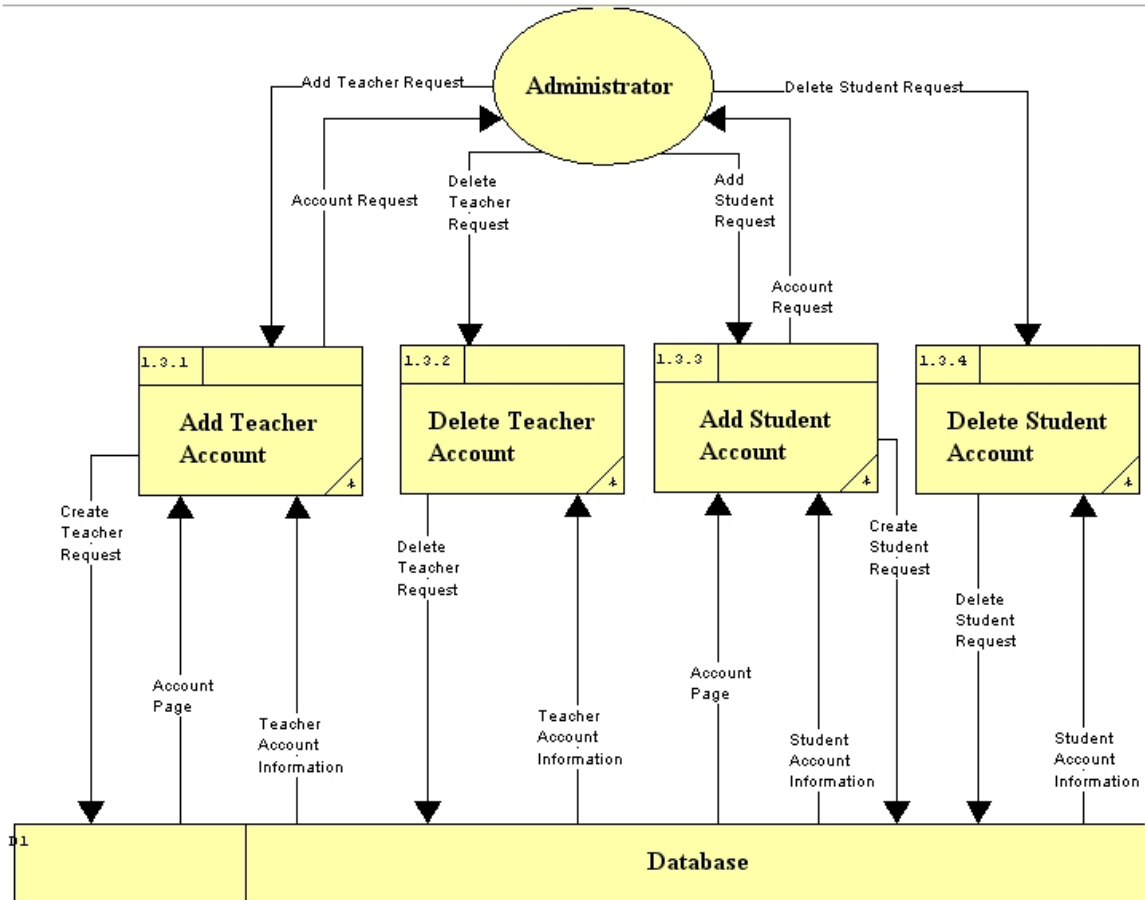

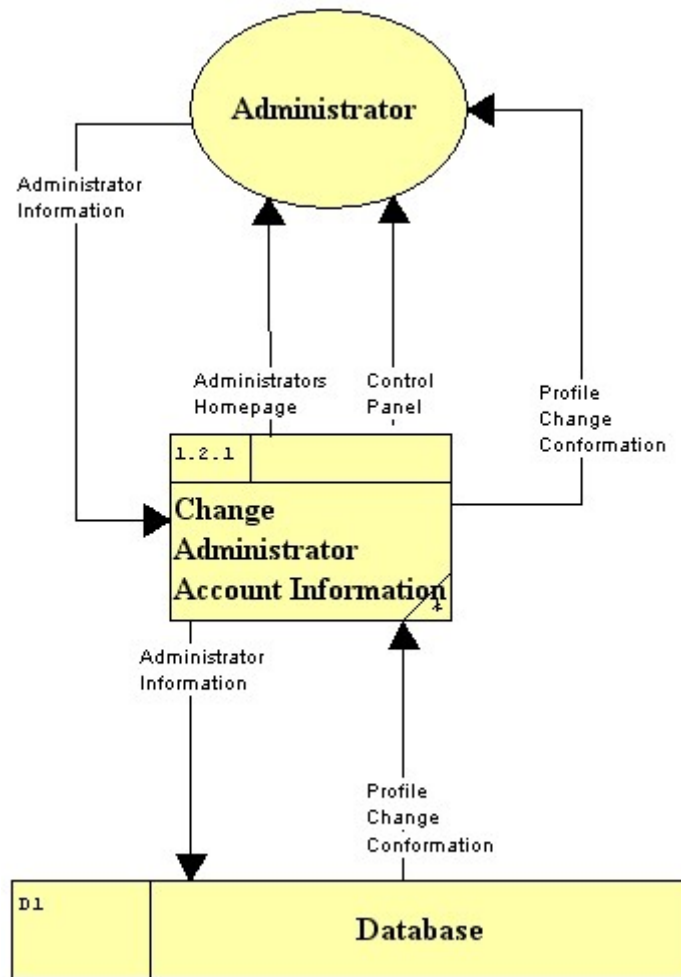
6.3: Administrator Level 1



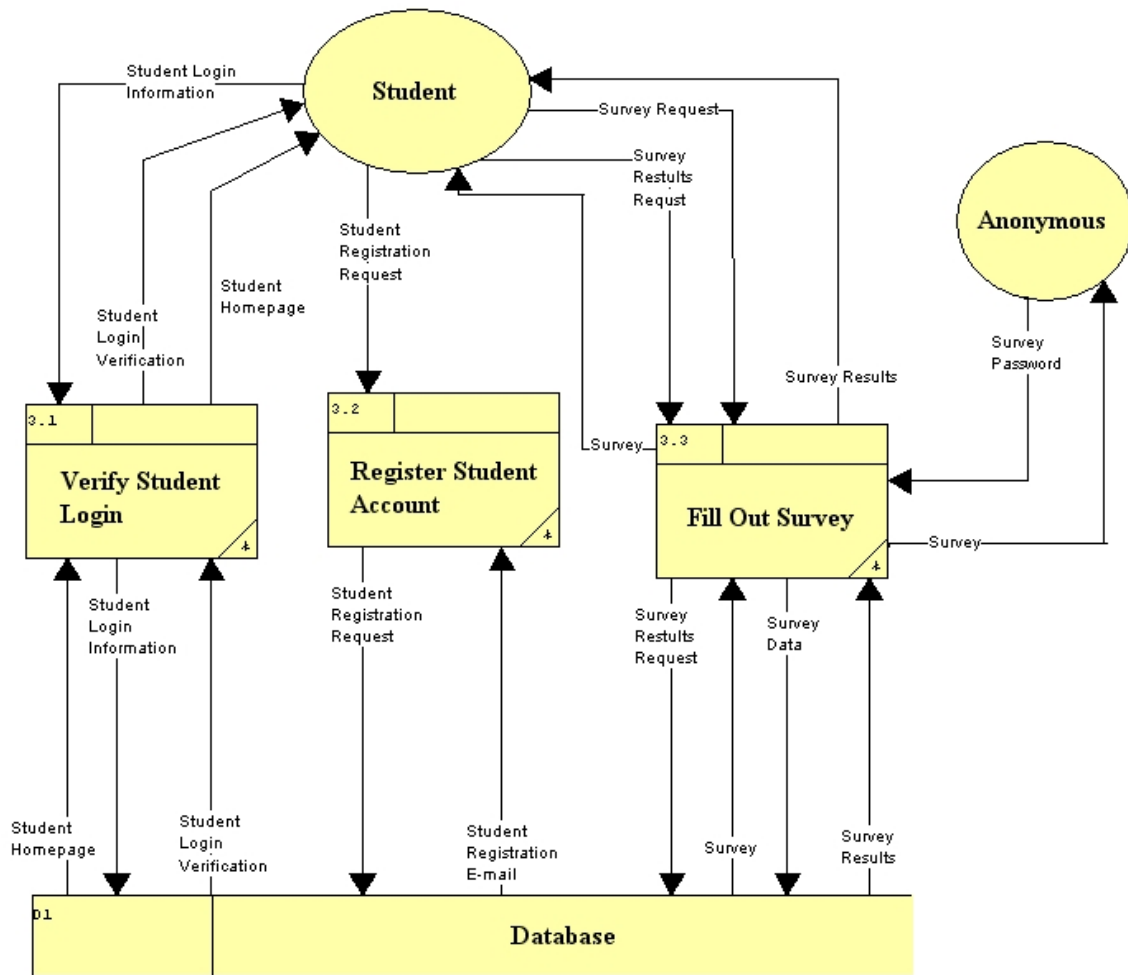

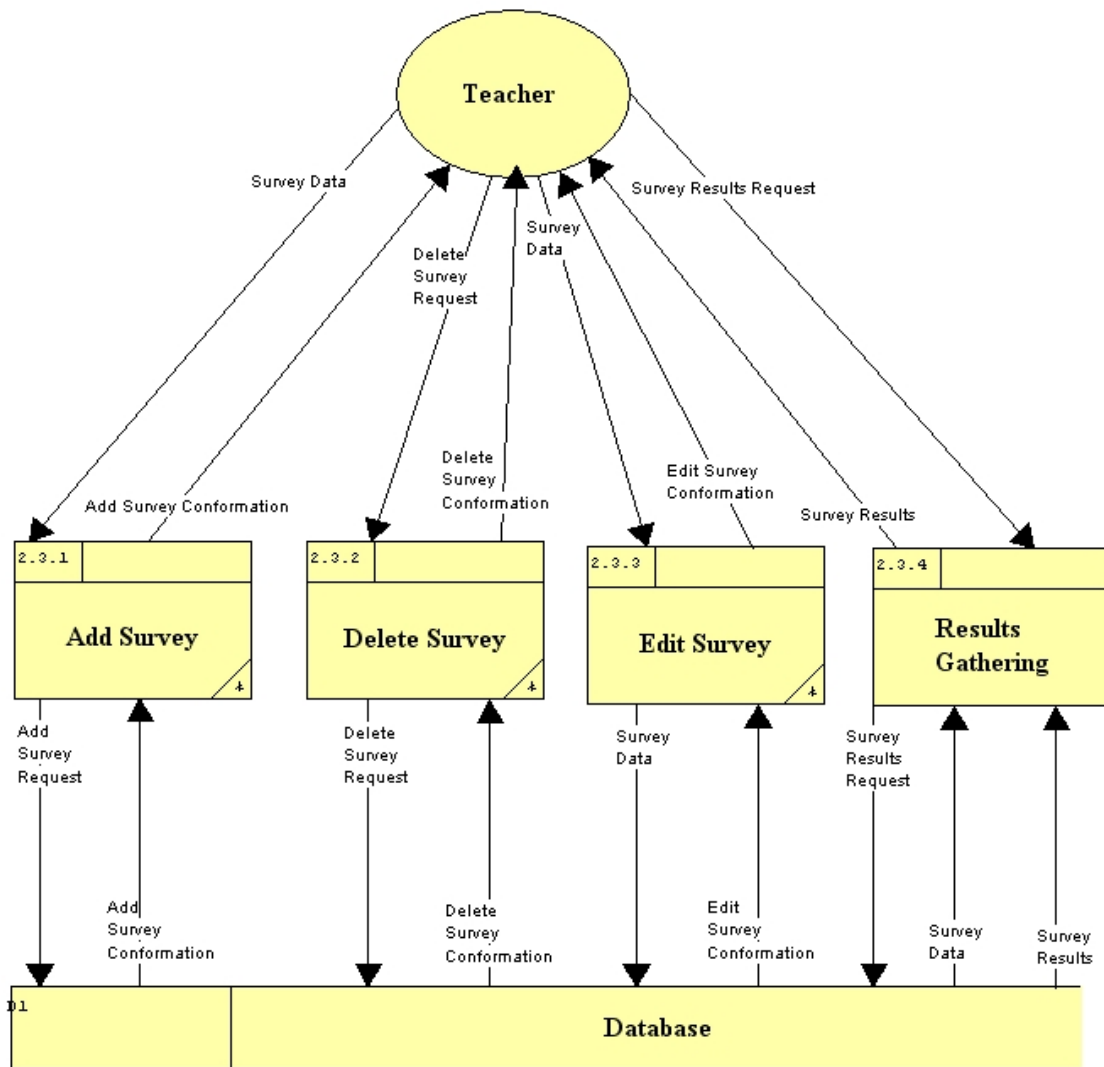

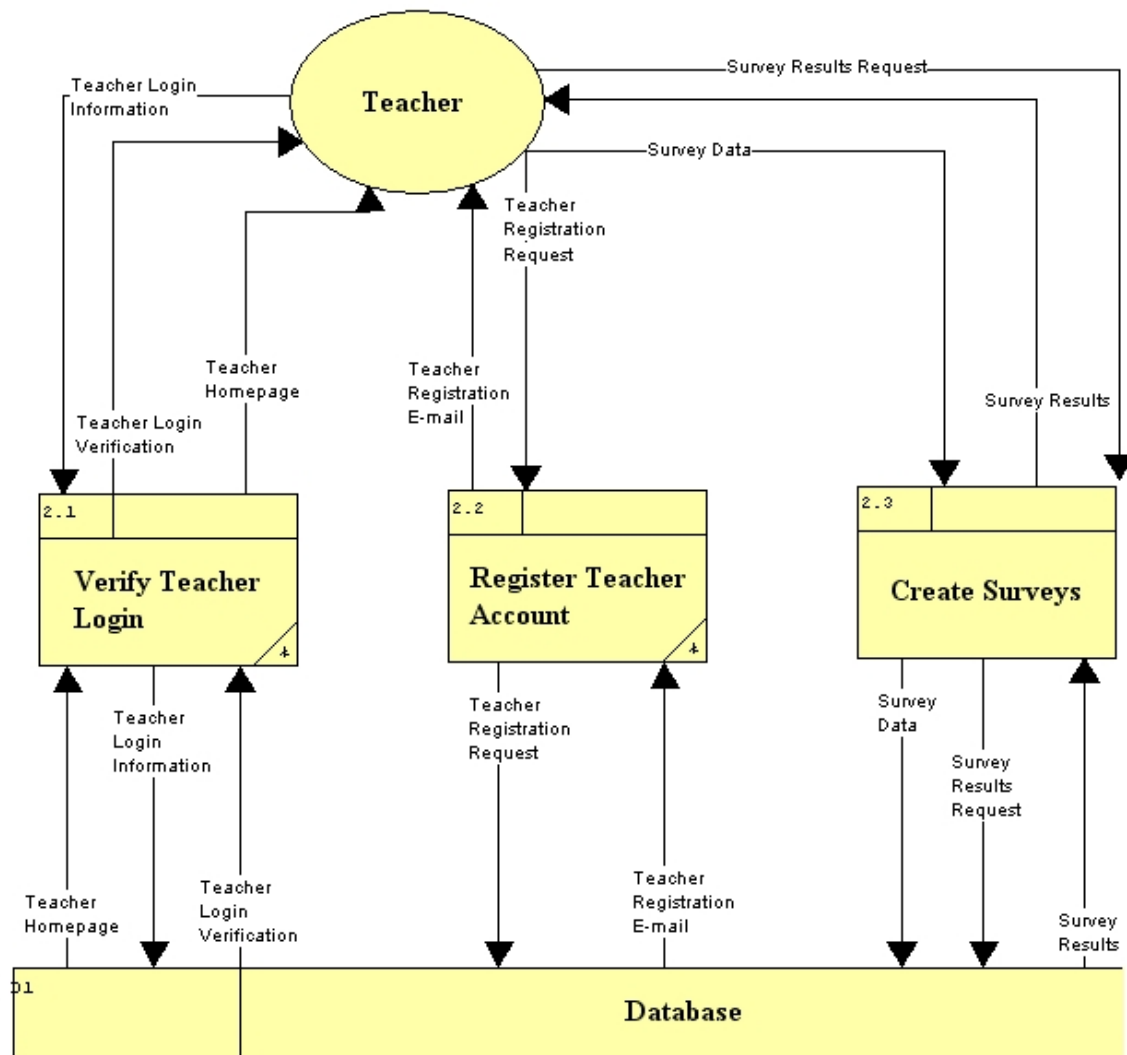
