Showing Lim the Prototypes, and compiler

Prototypes:

- Link underneath password—make it stand out better
- Background—fine, be mindful of color pallets and textures as you go further into prototyping
- On the top of the screen—give user status
 - Makes it clearer for multi users, ie faculty member is also a co-coordinator, make the options shown
- If they have not chosen a course assignment should not be shown, have a place holder instead until a course is clicked.

Student screen:

- Logged in and chosen a course—how would they change to a different course?
 - Idea: go home and be presented with more courses
 - process should be easy enough and users must understand how to do it
- The other decisions—Putting the course are on the right—make it more like blackboard—easier to understand, see what looks good as a user, what is the best design?

Compiler:
