Any changes to our user view of CACTUS since the preliminary design? What should every page look like? Paul User Interface Expert can make changes to the design or layout of Cactus if any changes needed.

File Recovery when problems are submitted. Files will be in the database. How will we handle submissions? Are submissions going to be locked after one submission? If so will cactus be requiring a time limit for judges to send back an acceptance feedback? Will Cactus allow submissions to be sent and then the most updated submission to be judged?

Data we want to be archival: Teams who won previous contests 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup>?

We can store the data in a CSV file.

Cactus will use one Spectator account for every spectator who wants to see the system.

Opening accounts on day of for spectator if we make more than one spectator account.

Data that will be needed to be recovered are clarifications, the scoreboard, and problem submissions.

We need to plan a test date for testing scalability. 30 teams 10 judges and any number of spectators will be needed. If we can combine our team and  $P = NP$  for this test we may be able to get more people and also kill two birds with one stone.
