Contestant prototype was presented to Darren Lim.

Tabs would be very easy to maintain within code- Dr. Lim approves

Regarding chat window- pull from IRC window and discuss as a team whether or not it would be a good format.

- Find things we like from other websites to pull design ideas.

Using Java: we are somewhat limited regarding the "look and feel"

Think about common accepted layouts of most web pages/ log-in screens, etc.

- Any tabs that are commonly clicked to go back and forth should be placed next to each other
- Perhaps allow users to move tabs (as in Google Chrome or in Excel)

Possibility to allow for more than one file for browse/submit.

Combine "History Data" and "Combo Box" ? – For simplicity reasons

- Include 'pending' (might be tricky)
- Must take into account what to do with multiple submissions: grading based on most recent submission?

Perhaps include an option for System Admin to choose whether or not to have time penalty for wrong submissions.

- If this is included, we must take make the rules of the competition clear in regards to grading

Judges must score the problem by a case-by-case basis.

Start to layout the scoreboard prototype.

Change to contestant interface: when/where does team choose language?

- Problem selection?
- Allow teams to switch language throughout competition
