Abstract needs to be reviewed (Reviewer from school X cannot review abstracts or papers from people from school X) Reviewers are assigned to abstracts this is held within the system

Abstract scanned by workshop committee chair in form or pdf

How registration is currently being done for paper submission –

Paper submission

**Notify** 

If accepted presenter sends in a camera ready version of paper

Register for conference

When they show up pick up conference materials check in is required if had not paid yet.

Can have different roles throughout the conference, but do not need to register for each role.

Can submit a paper without registering for conference.
